FAMILY PROMISE FUND RAISER

The display contains numbers from 1 to 100. These numbers represent a dollar donation toward the Family Promise organization. We ask that members of the congregation take a number or multiple numbers and donate the total of those numbers to Family Promise. The goal of the fundraiser is to have EVERY number taken from the board. If every number is chosen, and the donation in that amount is made, then Good Shepherd will have raised \$5,050 to help homeless families in Washington County.

Here is what you need to do:

Select one or more numbers – each number represents the dollar value of your donation.

Place the number(s) removed from the board, along with your(s) donation in the donation envelopes provided at the display. (Checks should be made to **Family Promise**)

The donations are tax deductible and if you would like a donation receipt, please fill out the donation card provided at the display table and place the card in the envelope with your donation. A receipt for your donation will be mailed to you. Place the donation envelope into the donation box at the display or in the offering plate when we collect our tithes and offerings.
